Volunteers will drive the route taken by the riders - be careful
VOLUNTEER HOURS - 8:00 AM TO 4:30 PM

** These instructions start West of Bastrop TX. at the intersection of Highway FM-1209 and Highway 71.

- Go North on FM-1209 approximately 3.6 miles to FM-969. Turn left.

- Travel 7.8 miles to the Webberwood Road and turn left (Webberville Volunteer Fire Department is just North of this road). Travel 0.45 miles to get to Webberville County Park. Refer to the BreakPoint Layout for details. You are parking along the road near the BreakPoint, and if additional space is needed, another parking lot is available another 1/4 mile further along the roadway. The National Multiple Sclerosis Society has rented all fields at this park for the day. Riders will enter the BreakPoint from Webberwood Road, but a special path is going to allow riders to exit to the West, and cyclists will need to push their bikes to Post Oak Road.
